

Community Survey on Participation in Planning Consultations

Eastbourne Borough Council is conducting a survey into how local people and businesses participate in consultations on planning issues that affect their local area. The aim of the survey is to understand what we can do to make consultations on planning issues more accessible.

Each completed survey will be entered into a prize draw with the opportunity to win £100. Terms and conditions apply.

Terms and Conditions

- 1) To enter the prize draw, you must complete the on-line survey, or return a fully completed survey form to the Eastbourne Borough Council Customer Contact Centre (1 Grove Road, Eastbourne, BN21 4TW) by the closing date
- 2) The prize draw is open from Monday 14 November 2016 to midnight on Friday 9 December 2016. By entering, entrants agree to abide by each and all these terms and conditions.
- 3) All complete entries received by the closing date will be entered into the prize draw to win £100, which will be sent to the winner in the form of a cheque. The prize must be accepted as offered.
- 4) There is a maximum of one entry per person for the prize draw. No bulk, machine generated, consumer group or third party entries or those suspected as such will be accepted. Any attempted interference with the running of this prize draw will result in a void entry.
- 5) One winner will be selected in a random draw from all valid entries received by the closing date. The winner will be notified by email or telephone during the week commencing 12th December 2016.
- 6) All reasonable effort will be made to contact the winner; however, if the winner is not contactable or the prize is not claimed within fourteen days of notification, the winner will forfeit the prize and a further winner will be selected from all remaining valid entries.
